DATA BANKS

The following is a letter received by one of our crew members in answer to a letter he sent to Paramount regarding some questions he had. We hope this information will help you in your studies of STAR TREK.

Dear Wayne,

Thank you for your letter (and also for the SASE).

In "Time Squared", Shuttlecraft #5 was named the El Baz after Farouk El Baz, a NASA Planetary Geologist who worked with the Apollo missions.

In "Ensigns of Command", Shuttlecraft #5 was named the Onizuka after Ellison Onizuka, one of the Challenger crew who died almost four years ago. The number of the shuttle was supposed to have been changed, but our graphics artist was in the hospital at the time, and it was overlooked.

Dr. Pulaski has transferred off of the Enterprise to continue her work in genetics (her specialty as seen in "Unnatural Selection"). This has not been explained in an episode, although it might be later in the season. We are leaving the door open for the character to return as a guest.

As for naming one of our ships after the Challenger crew, as you can see by the answer to your first question, we have done so, although it was only a shuttle. This, however, is established format ... ships are named after famous sailing vessels, and shuttles are named after astronomers/astronauts.
