


CAPTAIN'S LOG, STARDATE 44531.2

IT IS WITH A HEAVY HEART THAT I JOIN THE ARMADA AT SECTOR 93 TO BEGIN OUR OFFENSIVE AGAINST THE ROMULANS. AS WE PREPARE FOR WAR, THERE ARE STILL TOO MANY UNANSWERED QUESTIONS. 

ASK NUMBER ONE

THE QUESITON HAS BEEN ASKED ABOUT HOW OUR SHIP GOT IT'S NAME, AND IF THERE HAVE BEEN ANY OTHER SHIPS NAMED KELLY. AFTER CHECKING MANY SOURCES, I WAS ABLE TO FIND ONLY ONE SHIP CALLED KELLY. SHE WAS A SMALL FISHING BOAT WHOSE REGISTRY WAS OUT OF BLACKMOORE, IRELAND. THE SHIP AND IT'S FOUR MAN CREW WERE REPORTED MISSING AFTER A SEVERE STORM IN NOVEMBER OF 1879. FINDING NO TRACE OF SHIP OR CREW, AUTHORITIES PRESUMED THE SHIP SUNK AND THE CREW DROWNED. THIS IS THE ONLY MENTION I FOUND OF ANY SHIP CALLED KELLY.

THE STARSHIP KELLY, OUR SHIP, WAS NAMED AFTER THE KOMSOMOLSK CLASS DREADNOUGHT U.S.S. KELLY NCC-3453. SHE WAS DESTROYED IN BATTLE WITH THE KLINGONS STARDATE 8610.5. ACCORDING TO STARFLEET RECORDS, THE KELLY GOT ITS NAME FROM COLIN PURDIE KELLY. A U.S. WAR HERO IN WORLD WAR II. KELLY WAS BORN IN MADISON, FLORIDA, ON JULY 11TH 1915. HE WAS A CAPTAIN IN THE U.S. ARMY AIR FORCE. WHEN THE JAPANESE ATTACKED PEARL HARBOR IN 1941. HIS B-17 BOMBER ATTACKED THE JAPANESE CRUISER ASHIGARA ON DECEMBER 10TH 1941, SCORING SEVERAL DIRECT HITS. BUT HIS PLANE WAS HIT BY ENEMY FIGHTERS AND SET AFIRE. KELLY ORDERED HIS CREW TO PARACHUTE TO SAFETY, WHILE HE STAYED WITH HIS SHIP. HE WAS KILLED WHEN HIS CRIPPLED PLANE CRASHED ON THE PHILIPPINE ISLAND OF LUZON. CAPT. KELLY WAS POSTHUMOUSLY AWARDED THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS. IT IS BECAUSE OF HIS OUTSTANDING VALOR AND HEROISM THAT STARFLEET COMMAND DECIDED TO NAME ONE OF ITS CLASS ONE STARSHIPS IN HIS AS THE CREW OF THE U.S.S. KELLY WE SHOULD STRIVE TO UPHOLD THE FINEST TRADITIONS SET FORTH BY CAPTAIN COLIN PURDIE KELLY.

THE UNFOUNDED RUMOR THAT THE OFFICIAL IN CHARGE OF SHIP'S NOMENCLATURE NAMED THE KELLY AFTER AMERICAN ACTRESS GRACE KELLY WAS QUICKLY LAID TO REST BY FLEET HEADQUARTERS.
















My parents got a divorce when I was little. My mom got remarried and we moved to Virginia.





TREKKIN'

Star Trek hobbyists fall into three categories. The first are the trekists. Trekists are people who may follow the syndicated Trek episodes, or on occasion, may attend a few conventions but who are not actively involved in collecting memorabilia. They are usually in a club because they want to be with a spouse or a friend. They are not trivia addicts, nor do they want to be. second group of hobbyists is called trekkies. Trekkies make up the body of the club and will see the movies or episodes more than once. They have some trivia knowledge and know some titles and story lines. They will attend conventions on a more regular basis than trekists and will collect some of the memorabilia. Last, but definitely not least, is the group called trekkers. These are the ones who are the go-getters, the leaders of the club. They greet one another with "Live long and prosper" while displaying the Vulcan sign; and every conversation will be formulated with Trek quotes. They not only watch the episodes and movies, but they own them on video tape. They are so involved that they live on a ship that flies around the galaxy to various planets and star bases. Some have taken on titles such as "Captain" and "Number One" and are very proud when someone acknowledges them as such. buy all of the comic books, novels, technical manuals, collectible plates, and even pewter replicas of the ships. They attend every convention no matter the place or the cost and know every minute piece of trivia. They eat, drink, and sleep Trek. From trekist to trekker, all are happy to be a part of Trek.

Trek warps past original

Wil Wheaton is leaving the show, and Leonard Nimoy may make a guest appearance. That's the news from Star Trek: The Next Generation, which surpasses the original with its 80th episode this week—one more than the 79 shot for the original Star Trek.

"We've discussed with Leonard Nimoy the possibility of his appearing on the show. But no plans have been made," says Rick Berman, executive producer of the syndicated series.

Berman says two ideas for using Spock were drawn up some time ago. "One was to have him come back as a man 80 years older, which wouldn't be a problem because Vulcans age slower. The other was a story that dealt with a unique form of time travel. That would have presented Spock at his own age." The latter sounds more likely, since in an episode last season, Sarek, Spock's 202-year-old dad, paid a visit to the Enterprise and seemed to suggest his son had died.

The departure of Wheaton, who plays Ensign Wesley Crusher, is still top secret but should take place within a handful of episodes. The actor, best known for his

part in the film "Stand by Me," has a number of other projects to pursue, including another TV series for Paramount, which produces Star Trek.

Meanwhile, the series will go ahead with storylines that feature Commander Riker (Jonathan Frakes) waking up to discover that 16 years have gone by and that he's now the captain of the Enterprise—but he can't remember how he got there; Councilor Troi (Marina Sirtis), who is gifted with empathetic abilities) finding herself empathetically blind; and Captain Jean-Luc Picard (Patrick Stewart) being badly hurt in a shuttlecraft accident and left stranded on a deserted island.

For the 80th episode itself (appropriately titled "Legacy"), the crew of the Enterprise face a distinctly 20th-century challenge: gang warfare. When two crew members are taken hostage, the Enterprise is forced into a rescue attempt with one of two gangs that run a space colony.
